

WKC Ontario Provincial Information

Welcome to the 2025 WKC Ontario Provincial Championships. This event will determine which competitors are eligible to attend the WKC Canadian Nationals held in Gatineau, May 16th-18th. The top 8 competitors in each division can attend the nationals and compete in that division. Note: at the Nationals you can only compete in divisions that you qualified for. In sparring you can move up or down a weight class at the Nationals, however once you make the team you must compete at the weight you qualified in for the World Championships.

Start Times:

All -9yrs, 10-11yrs, 12-13yrs and 14-15yrs will start at 9:00am. All 16-17yrs and Adults will start at 11:30 or first available ring.

Format for Kata / Weapons

The top 8 competitors in each division qualify for the nationals. If there are 8 or less competitors, there is only 1 round of competition. If there are more than 8 competitors, there will be a playoff for the final two positions. In the first round the top 6 advance (The 3 medallists and the 4th, 5th and 6th place competitor) The remaining top 4 competitors compete again in a separate round for the final 2 spots. Competitors compete in reverse order, and scores from that round only determine the top two advancing.. A drop or re-start is allowed, competitors are scored on the re-started form then the score keeper uses a minus .05 deduction from total score. A second drop is a zero score.

Format for Point sparring

The top 8 competitors in each division qualify for the nationals. If there are 8 or less competitors, there is only 1 round of competition. If there are more than 8 competitors, there will be two rounds of competition. In the first round, the top 4 competitors (3 medallists and 4th place) advance to the nationals. Round 2 consists of the remaining fighters, the top 4 from round also advance. (once the top 4 fighters are established, the division ends)
